Will I be required to obtain a new Prior Authorization for my existing medication?

Your company has waived the need to get a Prior Authorization for your current medication refills for the first 90 days of this plan year. If you start a new medication or your current Prior Authorization has expired, you will be required to obtain a Prior Authorization before your medication can be sent to you.
